3.2 Definitions

Game Service The collection of end-to-end functionality provided that enables connected and/or multiplayer mobile

games.

Game Service Provider The business entity that provides the functionality of a Game Service to Users. A GSP may provide and

manage all Game Service functionality itself, or make these available through business-to-business

relationships.

Game Client The portion of a mobile game (connected, multiplayer) that executes on the User's device that is

specifically concerned with interacting with the OMA Game Service. General reference to the game client

excludes device-resident game fiction.
