IMPS 1.3 Implementation Guidelines provide common and actual practices currently implemented and deployed of IMPS 1.3 [OMA-IMP13]. The benefits of IMPS 1.3 Implementation Guidelines include the description of common solutions to recurring requirements, smoother interactions between clients and servers from different vendors based on a common set of practices, avoidance of a multiplicity of custom-based solutions and in general, improvements to IM services.
